HDAPP at UC Davis supports the University's commitment to a harassment and discrimination-free work and learning environment for all members of the UC Davis community by:

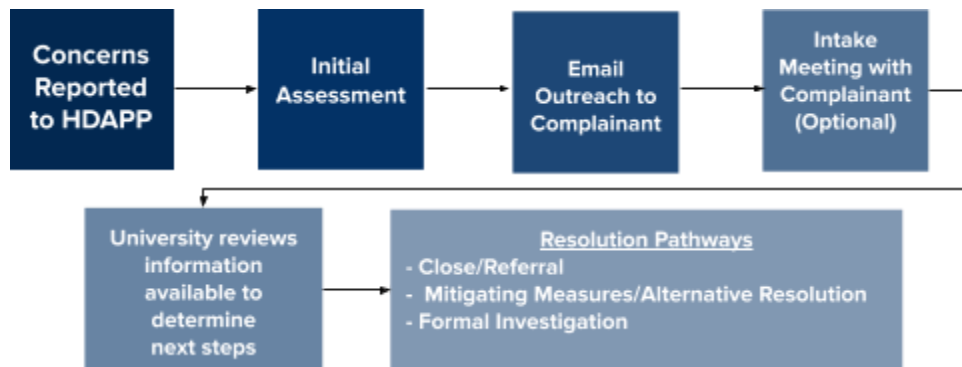
- preventing harassment and discrimination from occurring at UC Davis by educating the campus communities about the issues.
